### LUNCH INSTRUCTIONS

All crews will have to restrooms in the **Fellowship Halls** of Epworth United Methodist (Ripley) and Ravenswood First Baptist Church. Both churches will be unlocked from 11:30 AM to 1 PM.

Epworth is located at 299 Church St NORTH (the north is very important for GPS) in Ripley (large brick church across from library).

FBC Ravenswood is 215 Ann Street in Ravenswood (large white church/red doors on corner of street).  
**Please use red double doors.**

Brothers' Keeper is a mission-minded camp. All participants are asked to conduct themselves at all times in a way that glorifies God, the life of Jesus Christ and that further builds the wholesome relationship and reputation Brothers' Keeper has in the community!

## Brothers' Keeper Reminders

We all hate rules and hearing "no, you can't do that." We have freedom in Christ but the important thing to remember is that in our freedom, we want to be great representatives of Christ in all we do!

We ask that everyone help in self-policing so that we hear less of what we can't do and more of what we can do!

### CLOTHING

As we serve, our actions and appearance speak loudly and have the potential to influence the community's perception of Brothers' Keeper and most importantly our witness for Christ. Choosing modest clothing helps to avoid distractions and misunderstandings both on the project site and in camp. We ask that all groups choose apparel consistent with our guidelines.

Please be aware that everyone must wear shirts with sleeves. No tank tops, crop tops, muscle shirts, torn or ripped t shirts, halter tops, spaghetti straps or midriff tops.

**The Brothers' Keeper shirts may not be ripped, sleeves torn off or midriff removed.**

All males must wear a shirt **at all times** including at the pool. Swimsuits should be modest (one piece for females). We know that this is not an easy rule, but if a suit doesn't meet our guidelines, please wear a t-shirt (males are also required to wear a shirt when swimming and your BK work shirt for the day is fine and a good way to get it clean!!!).



Our students will bend, twist, sit, climb and crawl as we love and serve on our project teams. Shorts will only get shorter with these activities. Here's how we define short: Let arms fall to the side – if fingers touch skin, make sure students wear a longer pair (whether male or female).

If clothing brought does not meet our guidelines, students will be asked to purchase the appropriate clothing at their expense before participating in any activities.

### PARKING

It is extremely important that no one park their vehicle in or around the circle at the Dorms at the top of the hill. Large vans, buses and emergency vehicles are unable to turn around without a tremendous amount of difficulty when vehicles are parked in and around the circle. This includes along the side of the circle. Please park completely out of the circle and down the hill. All vehicles should park at an angle on the drive with the part of the vehicle body closest to the drive angled toward the bottom of the drive. Unloading and loading is permitted, but please make sure to move your vehicle out of the circle as soon as possible so that everyone is able to get in and out easily!

### PROJECT TEAM ASSIGNMENTS

Project Teams are carefully assessed and assigned a mix of adults and youth from all camp participants to properly complete each project. No individuals whether youth or adults may switch assigned project teams.

### TRANSPORTATION

Every person in your group must have transportation to and from Parchment Valley. The same number of seats and seatbelts must be available for transportation during the week to and from our project sites. Drivers during the week must be 21 years old or older. Please make sure enough transportation is available for every member of your group!
